

TOURNAMENT FILE CHECK

(for tournaments of 28 games or less)

The tournament file exported by TSH or created using Aupair software should be as accurate as possible in regard to the names supplied prior to emailing to the WESPA Ratings Officer.

In order to check that your tournament file has the correct names, you should follow these steps:

1. If you do not have AuPair on your PC, download the latest AuPair software from <http://www.scrabble.org.au/resources/software.htm> into the directory which contains the *.tou file you intend to send
2. Save the text file at <http://www.wespa.org/latest.txt> into the same directory , saving as rating.dat instead of latest.txt
3. Open your Aupair *.exe file in a DOS window and load your tournament file
4. Invoke the command Other-> Check Spelling. A list of mismatched names will appear
5. For names which are misspellings, correct the name in your *.tou file
6. Repeat Step 4 until the only names remaining are players new to the international rating system
7. Email the Ratings Officer the final *.tou file, along with country of residence of those new players whose names did not match
